

## Dominion Curling Club Championship

### Regional Eligibility:

1. The club represented by the team must be affiliated with and a member in good standing of their Regional Association. The members of the team must be members in good standing of the club.
2. Each club will declare one men's team and one women's team of four players that play together in the club. These two teams will represent their club as the men and women club champions.
3. How or when the club declares this team is up to the individual club.
4. Only 1 player on the team can have participated in the 08/09 and/or 09/10 curling seasons in the following:
  - a. Provincials: Men, Women, Mixed, or Senior
  - b. Played in a WCT event.
5. The following Superleagues will not be eligible to be Club Champions:
  - a. Saville Superleague – Northern Alberta Curling Association
  - b. Calgary Winter Club Superleague – Southern Curling Association
  - c. Airdrie Superleague – Southern Curling Association
  - d. Sexsmith Superleague – Peace Curling Association
6. 2 players on the team can be less than 20 years of age but must be a minimum of 18 years of age as of December 31, 2009.
7. If a spare is required, a maximum of 2 players from the team's curling club must play lead and/or second. A spare cannot skip or play 3rd.
8. Each participant must only play in one Regional Association Club Championship.

### Format:

1. All games will be eight (8) ends with ties being decided by a full extra end.
2. Each club will pay an entry fee of \$200 per team.
3. Clubs must declare their intention to participate (and submit payment to SACA) by January 15, 2010 and supply the participant names to SACA by March 1, 2010. All entries will go directly to a Southern Qualifying Event. This Southern Qualifier, to determine 3 teams to go to the Provincials, will be played at the Acadia Recreation Centre, Calgary, March 19-21, 2010. The number of days will be determined once all entries have been received.
4. Each Regional Association will define the format of their regional club championship. The following is the breakdown of provincial participants: 3 SACA, 3 NACA, and 2 PCA. Provincials will be held at the Grande Prairie Curling Club October, 22-24, 2010. The winners will represent Alberta in Charlottetown & Cornwall, PEI for Nationals on November 23-28, 2010.
