

Dominion Curling Club Championship

Regional Eligibility:

1. The club represented by the team must be affiliated with and a member in good standing of their Regional Association. The members of the team must be members in good standing of the club.
2. Each club will declare one men's team and one women's team of four players that play together, on the same team in a sanctioned club league in the most recent season. These two teams will represent their club as the men and women club champions.
3. If the club has ONLY Mixed/Open leagues, teams will be allowed to be formed using same gender players; however players must all play in the same league.
4. A maximum of one replacement player from the club can play lead.
5. How or when the club declares this team is up to the individual club.
6. Only 1 player on the team can have participated in the current or previous 4 curling seasons in the following:
 - a. Provincials: Men, Women, Junior, or Senior
 - b. Played in a WCT Grand Slam event.
7. Teams from the following Superleagues will not be eligible to be Club Champions unless they play together in another club league:
 - a. Saville Superleague – Northern Alberta Curling Association
 - b. Calgary Winter Club Superleague – Southern Alberta Curling Association
 - c. Airdrie Superleague – Southern Alberta Curling Association
 - d. Sexsmith Superleague – Peace Curling Association
8. Two players on the team can be less than 20 years of age but must be a minimum of 18 years of age as of December 31, 2011.
9. Each participant must only play in one Regional Association Club Championship.
10. The Dominion has the sole authority to grant exceptions to these rules in extraordinary circumstances.

Format:

1. All games will be eight (8) ends with ties being decided by a full extra end.
2. Each club will pay an entry fee of \$200 per team.
3. Clubs must declare their intention to participate (and submit payment to SACA) by February 20, 2012 and supply the participant names to SACA by March 12, 2012. All entries will go directly to a Southern Qualifying Event. This Southern Qualifier, to determine 3 teams to go to the Provincials, will be played at the Huntington Hills Curling Club, March 30-April 1/12. The number of days will be determined once all entries have been received.
4. Each Regional Association will define the format of their regional club championship. The following is the breakdown of the provincial participants: 3 SACA, 3 NACA, and 2 PCA.
5. Provincials will be held at the Airdrie Curling Club, on October 19-21, 2012.
6. The winners will represent Alberta at the Scarboro Golf & Country Club, Scarborough, ON for Nationals on November 19 – 24, 2012.
